You can use the verb "will" to talk about the future. To form the contraction you use an apostrophe and double L.

I will swim.

I'll swim. (*contraction*)

We put the subject first ("I" in the sentence above), then "will", then the verb. In negative sentences we use "will not" or the contraction "won't".

I will not swim.

I won't swim.

To form a question, we use "will" first, then the subject, then the verb.

Will you swim?
